A consultation event will be held on Thursday 14th January 2016 from 3.00pm-7.00pm in the school's Henry Morris Room. You are invited to attend to view the development proposals. The project representatives of the school will be available to answer any questions you may have, and would welcome the opportunity to receive your feedback on the proposals. If you are unable to attend on Thursday 14th January 2016 from 3.00pm-7.00pm, you will still be able to view the plans, which will be displayed at the College until Friday 29th January 2016, and to provide any comments on forms which will be available. The feedback gathered as part of this consultation plays a crucial role in the further development of the scheme prior to plans being finalised and a detailed planning application being submitted.

The proposed development includes:

- Extending the existing five form entry (5FE) school by two additional forms of entry to 1050 pupils (7FE).
- Provision of a new purpose built performance hall for the school and community use
- Remodelling areas of the school to improve adjacencies
- The construction of an artificial turf pitch for Hockey
