

Dear Parents and Carers

To support your child working independently at home, subject teachers will be providing work and instructions for completing this work, through Show My Homework.

This guide will provide you with information on how your child can access their Show My Homework account, and what to do if they have forgotten their password. It will also provide you with guidance on how parents/carers can also log on to see what work has been set for their child, in order to support them with their working at home.

Accessing Show My Homework

Pupils and their parents/carers can log on to Show My Homework using the link at <https://www.cambournevc.org/portals>

Log in and password

For pupils:

You only need a PIN to log in for the first time. If you have forgotten your details and cannot reset your password, contact the school for a new PIN or [ask your parent](#).

For Parents/Carers:

If you already have an account, you can recover your password by clicking on the "Forgot Password" link

If you have never logged on before, you will need a parent code. Information is given on the next page on how your child can help you to get this code, without you needing to contact the school.

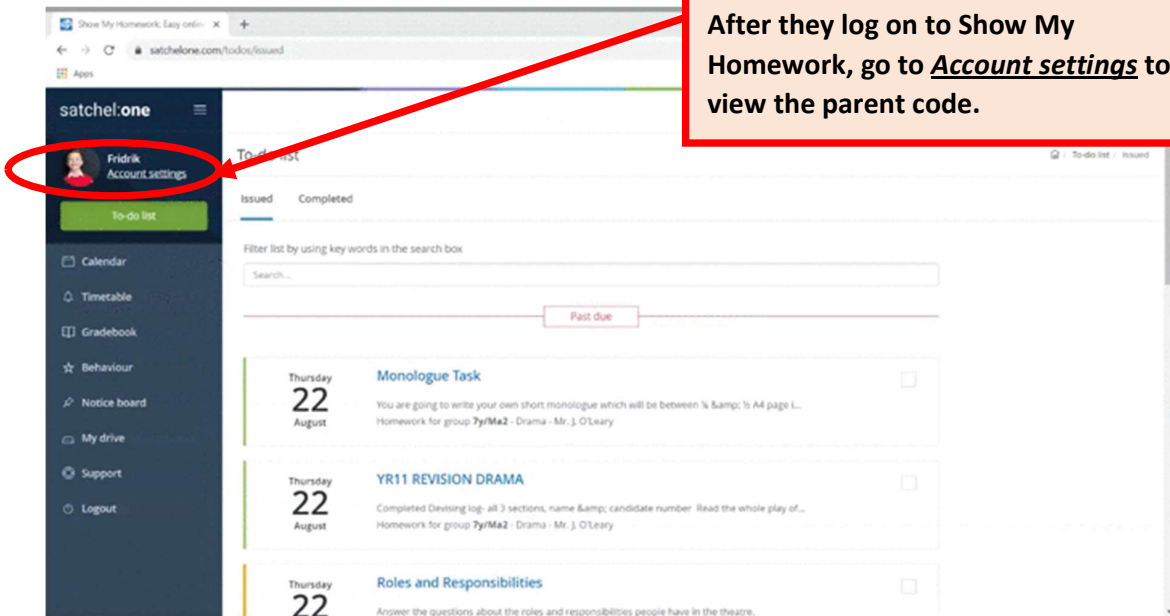

How pupils and parents can support each other to log on

Pupils can view parent codes.

A pupil who has access to their account can invite their parents to register.

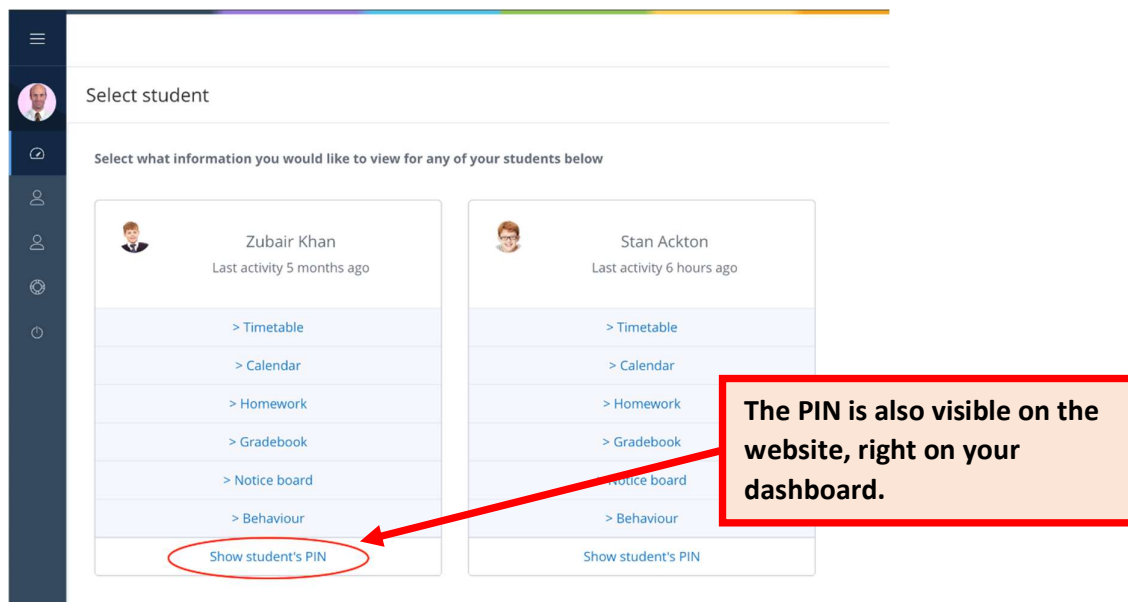
After they log on to Show My Homework, go to Account settings to view the parent code.



Parents can view pupil PINs

Parents are able to view their child's PIN and help them recover their account.

Open the Satchel One app on your phone or tablet and from the Menu go to *Settings > Student management*. You will be able to see the student PIN which they can use to reset their details.



The PIN is also visible on the website, right on your dashboard.
